

PAID 8-WEEK SUMMER CONSTRUCTION INTERNSHIP

TRACK I INTRODUCTION

In Track I, interns focus on building hands-on projects with tools. Interns receive an overarching introduction to career opportunities within the building trades and construction industry (i.e. carpentry, pipefitting and electrical etc.). Interns are also exposed to industry related careers such as architecture, surveying, estimating, project management, and design build.

For high school youth 16-21 years old with little or no experience in construction.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this internship, you must complete the BrookLynk Get Ready! training in the spring of 2023.

To be eligible for Get Ready!, you must face a barrier to employment. At least one of the barriers to employment listed below must apply to you, in order for you to be eligible.

- I am eligible for free or reduced lunch at school.
- I have an Individual Education Plan (IEP) or have a physical, mental, learning, emotional, or behavioral disability.
- I am pregnant, an expecting father, or a parent.
- I am/will be the first person in my immediate family to receive a high school diploma.
- I am/will be the first person in my immediate family to attend college.
- I and/or my parents immigrated to the U.S.
- I am currently taking English Language Learner (ELL) classes.
- I have experienced homelessness or stayed in temporary housing in the last 6 months.
- I have received or am currently receiving foster care services.
- I have been involved with the juvenile justice system.
- I dropped out of high school before receiving a diploma or GED, or am attending an alternative learning center.

ARE YOU BETWEEN THE AGES OF 16-24?

To be considered eligible for a summer internship, you must be 16-24 years old by June 1, 2023.

To be considered eligible for a summer internship, you must either live in Brooklyn Center, Brooklyn Park, or North Minneapolis. Or, you must attend a school located in either Brooklyn Center or Brooklyn Park.
