Hands-on lessons from industry professionals, tour local unions, job sites, and construction companies.



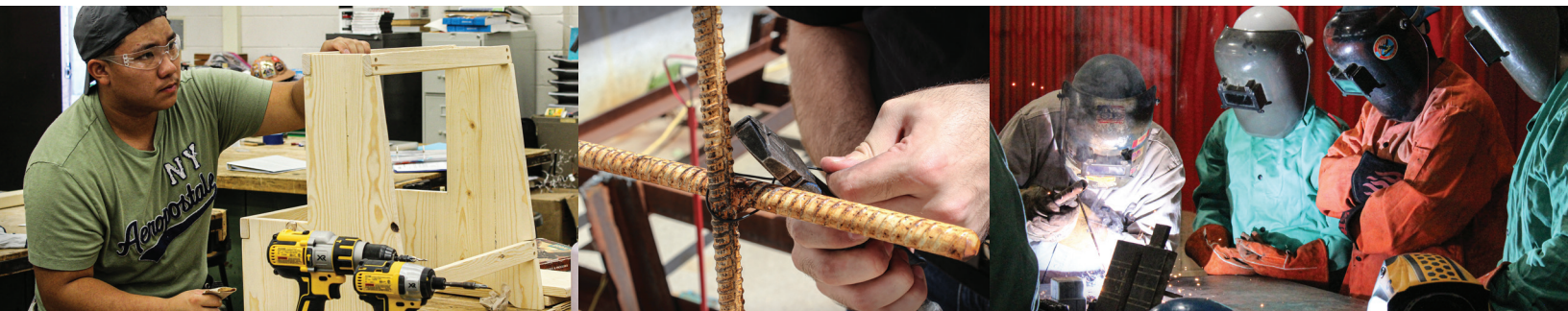

OVERVIEW

MN Trades Academy offers 2 levels of summer internship opportunities for metro youth - Track I Introduction and Track II Advanced

TRACK I

Interns receive an overarching introduction to career opportunities within the building trades and construction industry (i.e. carpentry, pipefitting and electrical etc.). Interns are exposed to industry-related careers such as architecture, surveying, estimating, project management, and building design.

***For High school youth aged 16-21 years old with little or no experience in construction**

WHAT YOU'LL LEARN

- Explore, investigate, and obtain information on construction careers
- Earn OSHA 10 certification
- Identify and safely use hand and power tools
- Build skills through construction-related experiences
- Read basic blueprints

TRACK II

This opportunity prepares interns to select a construction career path—union apprenticeship training, a construction-related post-secondary track, or direct entry into the construction workplace if desired. Interns visit different apprentice training centers where they receive training and supervision from industry experts as they complete projects.

***For High School youth 16-21 years old with an interest in investigating construction as a career choice**

- Workplace readiness skills
- Construction career networking and connections
- Construction math and financial management
