TRACK I INTRODUCTION

The main focus, and predominant time in Track I is spent on hands-on building with tools. Interns receive an overarching introduction to career opportunities within the building trades and construction industry (i.e. carpentry, pipefitting and electrical etc.). Interns are also exposed to industry-related careers such as architecture, surveying, estimating, project management, and building design.

For high school youth 16-21 years old with little or no experience in construction.

PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS

To be eligible for this internship, you must meet the following requirements.

All applicants must complete Step Up Work Readiness Training to be eligible for paid summer opportunities. Applicants should check their email the week of February 28 for their acceptance letter and training date(s). If you fail to complete Work Readiness Training you will no longer be eligible for a paid Step Up experience in 2023

ELIGIBILITY

TO BE ELIGIBLE YOU MUST

- Live in Minneapolis
- Be 14-21 years old on June 1, 2023
- Not be currently enrolled in college
- You can be enrolled in Post Secondary Education Options (PSEO)
- Be eligible to work in the U.S. By June 1, 2023

YOU MUST ALSO MEET ONE OR MORE OF THESE REQUIREMENTS

- Family income guidelines (see below)
- Live with a disability
- Have an IEP or 504 plan
- Be an English Language Learner
- Be pregnant or parenting
- Be experiencing homelessness or high mobility
- Be involved in the foster care system
- Have been involved in the justice system
